ABSC LEVEL 1 COACHING ACCREDITATION INFORMATION & PREREQUISITES

INTRODUCTION:

Steps 1, 2 & 3 are compulsory pre requisite components of the ABSC Level 1 Coaching accreditation. Steps 4 & 5 contain links to various documents regarding the governance of Billiards and Snooker both nationally and worldwide. By registering as an ABSC accredited coach you enter an understanding to agree and comply with this governance. Coaches must take it upon themselves to keep up to date with the latest regulations and policies available.

1. NSW Police Check

To apply for a National Police Certificate, please complete the application form online. You must complete all mandatory fields marked with an '*' on the form.

Once the form is complete, print and present in person with identification and payment at your nearest NSW Police Station within 30 days.

Payment can now be made online using a credit card just follow the prompts. However, you will still need to attend a Police Station to have your three forms of identification verified. Please allow 30 minutes for your application to be received before attending a Police Station.

3. ASADA eLearning Course 1 & 2

Level 2 ASADA accreditation expires every year on Dec 31st and must be retaken every subsequent year when it becomes available online, this is to ensure coaches are up to date with the latest anti-doping trends
