Tournament Conditions (read carefully before entering):

- **Eligibility:** As this event is a State Championship all entrants are required to:
 - (i) comply with NSW residency criteria; i.e. must be a NSW resident and have been permanently domiciled in the State of NSW for a minimum period of six (6) months immediately prior to this event;
 - (ii) not have previously competed in another State Championship of the same discipline (i.e. Billiards) in the same calendar year.
- The Championship will be played subject to Rules of Billiards prescribed by the WPBSA
- ABSC Playing Conditions and all matters pertaining to Player's Code of Conduct and Ethics will also be adhered to. Any breach of such rules or non-adherence to standard etiquette may result in disciplinary action being taken against the offenders.
- ***NOTE: No players or referees are permitted to smoke or consume alcohol whilst involved in playing or refereeing a game.***
- **Tournament standard dress is required:** Tailored trousers, long sleeve predominately plain coloured shirts buttoned at the wrist, bow ties, waistcoat, socks, dark colour dress shoes must be worn for all matches. Failure to comply with these conditions may result in forfeiture of the game.
- In the absence of official referees, unofficial referees will be supplied.
- Format & prize money determined subject to entries received.
- **Age group requirements U15 and U18 male and female events for Billiards and Snooker subject to entries.**
- Completed entry form and entry fee will be required before any player is permitted to compete.
- Entry forms must be signed by a Parent or legal Guardian
- Juniors must be accompanied by a Parent or legal Guardian.
- All players will be eligible to be selected to represent NSW at the upcoming Australian Juniors National Championships to be held in January 2018 at the South Australian Academy.
- Players must be under the age of the relevant championship age group as of 1/12/17,
- Players may also play up into older age group bracket, and can play in a max of 2 age groups.
