TOURNAMENT TERMS & CONDITIONS

Tournament Conditions (Please read before entering):

- Eligibility: The following eligibility criteria will apply:
 - You must be a current (2023/24 financial year) financial member of Snooker NSW (Inc).
 - You must be a NSW resident and have been permanently domiciled in NSW for a minimum period of six (6) months immediately prior to this event;
 - You must not have previously competed in another State Championship of the same discipline (i.e. Billiards) in the same calendar year.
- NOMINATIONS CLOSE – Sunday 26th MAY 10PM
- NOTE: All players must be financial members of Snooker NSW (Inc) for the current financial year.
- Rules: The Championship will be played subject to Rules of Billiards prescribed by the WPBSA.
- Any discrepancies will be referred to the Tournament Director for adjudication.
- Playing Conditions: ABSC Playing Conditions and the Player's Code of Conduct and Ethics. Any breach or non-adherence to standard etiquette may result in disciplinary action.
- Smoking and Alcohol: No players or referees are permitted to smoke/ vape or consume alcohol whilst involved in playing or refereeing a game – unless during an official session break.
- Dress: Tournament standard dress is required for all matches: Tailored trousers; long sleeve, predominantly plain coloured shirts buttoned at the wrist; bow ties; waistcoat; socks; dark dress shoes. Failure to comply with these conditions will result in forfeiture of match.
- Refereeing: All players will be required to referee matches as directed by the Tournament Director. Losing players in knockout rounds will be expected to referee the following matches, and if not required they must seek leave from the tournament director before leaving the venue.
- Completion of matches: As part of the entry conditions, all players must complete all their matches, regardless of their current form or where they may finish in their group.
- Format & Prize money: Round Robin then knockout. Prize money subject to entries received, with a minimum of \$1500. The NSW Billiards Rankings will be applied to determine seeding for the event
- Entry requirement: A completed online entry and fully paid entry fee is required before any player is permitted to compete.
